

## Change of legislation

### Guidance for the safe use of places of worship from 4<sup>th</sup> July

Alhamdulillah from 4<sup>th</sup> July, places of worship will be permitted to open for congregational prayer in line with Government Guidelines.

Masjid-E Tauheedul Islam would like to take this opportunity to provide some guidelines (see overleaf) to the wider Community and musallees in relation to the congregational prayers (Jamaat) of the 5 daily Salaah which will **commence from Fajar Salaah on Saturday 4th July 2020.**



## Guidelines and Information

Members of the community who intend to perform Salaah at Masjid-E Tauheedul Islam are requested to note the following:

---

**Timings for the masjid** – For Salah timings please visit [www.masjidetauheedulislam.com](http://www.masjidetauheedulislam.com)

- **Fajar** - 30 mins before and after Fajar
  - **Zohar** – 30 mins before and 30 mins after
  - **All other times** - 7.00pm to 23.30pm
- 

**Can I come to the Masjid?**

- Adults - Individuals and Elderly with underlying health conditions and anyone with confirmed or suspected **Covid-19 symptoms should refrain coming** into the Masjid and continue perform Salaah at home.
  - Children – Aged 7 or above are welcome to the Masjid, however they **must remain accompanied by an adult**, this will be kept under constant review.

**What do I need to do before coming to the Masjid?**

- **Wudhu (ablution) must be performed at home** prior to attending the Masjid.
  - Musallah (prayer mat) – You will be required to **bring your own Musallah**
  - Face Covering – It is **strongly recommended and encouraged to wear face coverings** whilst visiting the Masjid.
  - **Arrive Early** – To allow the volunteers plenty of time to assist you and make your arrival comfortable

**What to expect when I arrive at the Masjid?**

- Muallees will have their **temperature checked before entering the Masjid**.
  - **Hand sanitizer** stations will be in place for all Musallees to **apply on entry and exiting of the Masjid**.
  - **Jamat Khana will be given priority to the elders**, in case where the Jamaat Khana has reached capacity, please follow the instructions given by the volunteers.
  - Please **adhere to instructions** provided whilst at the Masjid and follow signage located around the premises.
  - The congregational Salaah will take place **with 2 meter** social distancing. This will stay under review.

**What about Jumuah Salah?**

- It will be **compulsory for all Musallees attending the Masjid to register their details** prior to attending **Jumuah Salah** using the online form [www.masjidetauheedulislam.com](http://www.masjidetauheedulislam.com). Details shall be securely destroyed after a 21-day period as per Governmental guidance.

Further advice and guidance shall be provided by the Imam at the masjid, we thank you for your cooperation and patience and request you to make Duaa that Almighty Allah make this task easy and remove this pandemic from us.
