

Masjid e Tauheedul Islam Important Duas

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ADMISSION INTO JANNAH

According to a hadeeth whosoever recites the following dua thrice in the morning and evening. It is upon Allah to please him on the Day of Judgement and admission into Jannah is a certainty for him:

I am content in believing in Allah as my Lord, Islam as my religion and Muhammad as the messenger. (Abu Dawud, Nasai)

PROTECTION AGAINST LEPROSY, BLINDNESS, INSANITY AND PARALYSIS

Recite three times in the morning and evening:

Glorified be Allah, the Magnificent, and all praise is His. And there is no power, no might besides that of Alla. (Musnad)

PROTECTION AGAINST ALL HARM

Allah will grant security to the person who recites the following dua thrice in the morning & evening. It is very effective for protection against harmful insects and creatures.

I seek protection in the excellent words of Allah from the injuries caused by His creation. (Mishkat)

PROTECTION OF ONE'S DEEN, LIFE, FAMILY AND WEALTH

Ma'qal bin Yasar arrates: Once I expressed my fears to Rasulullah over 5 things in my life. My first fear was that I would be misled or deviate from the Siratul-Mustaqim. The second was regarding my life. I feared harm or illness would befall me. The third was about my children, that they would suffer deeni or worldly harm. My fourth concern was my wife, that she too may suffer physical or spiritual harm. The fifth fear I had was over my wealth, should there occur a loss of income or property. After listening to my fears, Rasulullah taught me the following du'a:

May the blessings of Allah be on my faith, life, children, family and wealth.

(Kanzul Ummal)

Juwairiyyah (r.a) reports that Rasulullah said, "Whoever reads the following four Kalimahs 3 times after Fajar Salah will get reward far greater than he who makes Ibaadah of Allah significant From Fajar till Chaast (mid-morning)."

Glorified is Allah together with His praises in numbers equivalent to His creatures, in a manner befitting His pleasure, in weight equal to His Throne and in quantities equal to the ink of His words. (Abu Dawud, Muslim)

PROTECTION FROM ALL SERIOUS AND LIFE-THREATENING ILLNESSES

اَللَّهُمَّ اِنِّيُ اَعُونُ بِكَ مِنَ الْجُنُونِ وَالْجُذَامِرِ وَالْبَرَضِ وَسَيِّئِ الْأَسْقَامِرِ

O' Allah, I seek your refuge from Insanity, Mutilation, Leprosy and from all serious illnesses. (Nasai)

PROTECTION AGAINST ALL HARM

Aban bin Uthman an arrates that he heard his father saying that Rasulullah mentioned, "Whosoever recites the following du'a 3 times in the morning and evening will not be harmed by anything."

In the name of Allah, with whose name nothing in the heavens or earth can cause harm.

And He is the all-Seeing, all-Knowing (Mishkat)

THE ULTIMATE PAINKILLER

Hazrat Uthaman bin Abu al-'As Al-Thaqafi reported that he once complained of pain that he felt in his body to our beloved Prophet Muhammad Thereupon Rasulullah replied, "Place your hand at the place where you feel pain in your body and recite 'bismillah' three times and the following seven times:

I seek refuge with Allah and with His power from the evil that I find and that I fear (Muslim)

SAYYIDUL- ISTIGHFAR

Shaddad bin Aus in narrates that Rasulullah states that Sayyidul Istighfar (the most loftiest of all types of repentance), is that a servant says the following once.

O Allah! You are my Lord. There is no God besides You, You created me, I am Your slave and with all my strength, I remain steadfast to your promise and I beseech You to forgive me any evil I may perform. I humbly affirm what You bestow upon me and I plead guilty to my sins. Forgive me. For besides you there is none to forgive me. (Sahih Al - Bukhari)

70'000 ANGELS SEEK FORGIVENESS

Ma'qbal bin Yasar anarrates that Rasulullah said: "Whoever recites the following dua in the morning, 70'000 Angels are appointed by Allah who seek forgiveness on behalf of that person till the evening. Should he die during the day, he will die as a martyr. Whosoever recites this du'a in the evening will enjoy the same virtue till the morning."

Recite the above 3 times, thereafter the last 3 verses of Surah Al-Hashr (28 Chapter) once:

RECITE AFTER EVERY FARDH SALAAH

Allah says in a Hadith-e-Qudsi regarding a person who reads the below eleven verses after every Fardh Salaah: "I will make his final abode in Jannah, I will give him a place in Hathirat-ul-Quds (a special place in Jannah), I will look at him 70 times with a gaze of mercy, fulfill (his 70 needs, I will give him refuge and protection from his enemies and from those that envy him (Hasad) and give him the upper hand. (Ruhul Ma'ani)

TO SAFEGUARD ONESELF FROM BLACK MAGIC

Some duas are such that it will safeguard a person from the effects of Black magic.

Hazrat Ka'ab ul Ahbaar mentions that if I didn't recite some certain words regularly then the enemies would have transformed me in to a donkey with their black magic,

Someone enquired what these words are:
